MANIFESTO

The future of intercultural penetration and exchange lays in **encounters** between individuals and groups of people with common understanding of reality but who also embody a range of cultural differences. Such meetings allow a rich diversity of exchange. Not solely giving or taking, but giving and taking in exchange. To exchange ideas and techniques to be used for later work also entails the encounter with the otherness of people, a powerful agent of change. A personality develops and becomes richer by moving beyond the cultural definitions of own nationality, without losing the strength of the traditions and of the cultural characteristics inherited by birth. This picture portrays the aim of the **StrangeSpaces project**: to become a space for an encounter, where diversities find a common denominator through a performing arts event, like in the lake's reflection of the multitude of human beings. The encounter forms this place, this view, the history and you. You can see yourself in there. Even if it is not you.

THE PROJECT

StrangeSpaces is a project for performing arts in which the local spaces, the communities and the individual artistic expressions transform the transcultural encounter into a vehicle for change. The project StrangeSpaces and its final touring festival aims to the encounter with the "other" and to emphasize the role of the transcultural realities as a possible response to the increasing need of international performing art in local, national and global communities. With its program based on a touring festival, gatherings, workshops and political/artistic talk, the project aims to create an alternative platform for performing arts and to spread a wider message, underlining the need for a more sustainable and fairer society. **StrangeSpaces SWEDEN** is planned between the **18-05-2023** and the **03-06-2023** in three different regions and locations.



Teater Theatron

Teater Theatron is a small theater with big questions; a **community-oriented** non-profit organization with performing arts as its primary area. Themes that are driving our production are **break-up, migration, identity, belonging, rootlessness, civil courage and heroism**. We do not have a fixed stage, but see ourselves as a migrating theater group, based in Malmö and Lund. We want to play productions that create a natural meeting place where the boundary between us and them, both in the sense of actors and audience as well as among ordinary people, is blurred and where there is room for an honest and ongoing conversation. We never want to come up with answers, but instead ask questions that create reaction and reflection. We carry a strong conviction that with small things we can influence and contribute to a better world. Our aspiration is to be a current voice that takes on important reflections on the present that are created in the conversations between northern and southern Europe. **Additionally we strive for making performing art accessible to everyone.**

TeaterPi

TeaterPi is the creator of StrangeSpaces project.

TeaterPi creates theatre performances in Italian and wants to contribute, **locally and internationally**, to the development of performing arts through a **multi-medial and trans-cultural theater model**. Teater Pi originates from the effort of bringing together the Italian culture and other cultures, through a model of **theater that is at the same time unconventional, free and multi-medial**. Important tools in our productions are **multi-lingual expression** for “rootless” people; professional engagement of “street-professionals”. Above all: this is a sustainable initiative that takes the motto “**reduce-recycle- reuse**” in its literal sense. We want to contribute to the **international development of performing arts** through a production that combines classical and experimental themes into new expression forms.

In StrangeSpaces will contribute with the performance: **#LastDays - TimeNoMore**

#LASTDAYS - TimeNoMore

#LASTDAYS is a new chapter of the TimeNoMore anthology that develops through film and performing arts projects. #LASTDAYS is based on the script “The Man with the Flower in His Mouth” which is a one-act play, a tragicomedy whose main themes are the inability to communicate and the perception of reality. The play was first staged on 24 January 1922 at the Teatro Manzoni in Milan. It's about a man who knows he will die soon and who thinks about life and all the little details that everyday life offers. Luigi Pirandello, Nobel Prize in Literature, bases this dramatic text on a short story he wrote a few years earlier ("La morte addosso"). Teater π's version of the play will compose through a mixture of different art forms, languages and several dramaturgical works that are connected through improvisational works as well as the audience experience. The performance is divided into moments where music, dance and performance alternate. In this performance, the audience will constantly be involved in different ways. For the first time, Teater π is working with improvisation of various dramaturgical works in a format that is both multilingual and multimedial.


